| Vocabulary word   | Definition  |
|-------------------|---|
| abjure (v)        | to give up rights; to recant  |
| judge (n)         | a person chosen to interpret <b>laws</b> , decide on a winner, or settle a controversy      |
| jurisdiction (n)  | the territory or land in which <b>justice</b> and <b>laws</b> are administered and followed |
| jurist (n)        | an expert in <b>law</b>   |
| jury (n)          | a group of people sworn to abide by the <b>laws</b> to determine the truth                  |
| just (adj)        | <b>lawful</b> ; fair  |
| justice (n)       | fairness; rightfulness  |
| justification (n) | to fact that is said to prove that something is true  |
| justify (v)       | to prove; to offer  |
| perjury           | to break the <b>law</b> by lying; to break a formal promise; to break an oath               |
